StudioYou have put together a diverse panel of barrier breaking role models from This Girl Can, Nike and many more.

At Biddenham School, we believe PE is a subject that is integral to your child's personal, physical and mental wellbeing and want to be able to help show that regardless of background and ability, that getting active and staying active has multiple benefits.

The session outcomes will be:
