Dear Parent/Carer.

With only six weeks before the end of the school year, it's time to start thinking about the next year ahead. Therefore, I have sent you some information about opportunities for your child over this period.

The first list of events is about this half term. As you can see it is a very busy time for our students. There are Open Day visits, careers events, workshops and guest speakers. We are focused on giving students the skills and opportunities to achieve their potential and these events demonstrate this. I have included an overview of key events we are doing with students titled 'Sixth Form Events Calendar for June and July 2024'.

June also sees all students starting a UCAS application in their Skills lessons. This allows your child to collate all their academic achievements and compile a personal statement - this can then be utilised for an apprenticeship application at a later date if this is the route they wish to take. To that end, we are writing to inform you about a number of important events which have arranged two compulsory events for all students to attend.

Monday 17th June – Bedfordshire Higher Education and Apprenticeships Convention

We have managed to secure places for all students in the morning session at the Bedfordshire Higher Education Convention, which is being held on the Polhill Campus at the University of Bedfordshire (See map enclosed), for all our Year 12 Level 3 students.

Students are expected to make their own way to the university, for 9.15 am, when they will be registered by Biddenham Staff. They will also be expected to make their own way home.

Tuesday 18th June - Futures Information Evening, 6.30 pm, Main Hall

We have organised a Futures Information Evening for <u>students</u>, <u>parents and carers</u>, at which you will be given information on Student Finance, UCAS, apprenticeship opportunities and life away from home.

Our guest speaker will be Anna Gilbert from the University of Leicester. We will also have former students who will talk to you about the different career paths they have followed. In the past, parents and carers have found this evening essential and we very much hope to see you there. Presentations will begin promptly at 6:30pm, with refreshments being served afterwards.
