Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Information for September 2024

We hope your children have enjoyed a wonderful end to the term and their primary school years. It can be an emotional time, but it is important to mark these milestones and to look ahead to the future with positivity. We just wanted to write to you with a reminder of some of the details for the start of term and let you know how much we are looking forward to welcoming our new Year 7 students to Biddenham in September.

You will know from the Home - School agreement that you have already received that we place a strong emphasis on high expectations and working together to best support your child. The role of the tutor within this is significant and will continue to be so throughout your child's journey through Biddenham. We are attaching a copy of the Home - School agreement to this letter and tutor details for further reference.

The first day back

The first day back for our new Year 7 will be **Wednesday 4th September**. Students should arrive and go straight to the **main hall for 7.45am**. Pick up time will be **2.30pm**. They will have the whole day in school to familiarise themselves before the rest of the school return on Thursday. Please see the end of the letter for details about tutor group bases and this <u>link</u> for timings of the school day.

Uniform

We believe in a 'Look smart - think smart' approach to school uniform. All students are expected to wear full school uniform as shown on this <u>link</u>. It is important to note that the school blazer and tie are compulsory and the jumper is optional. Any head coverings need to be in the school uniform colours of navy or black. Students should wear trousers (not leggings) and shoes (not trainers). If students have <u>Dance on their timetable</u>, then on those days they should attend school in PE kit. Please see the <u>link</u> for more details.

Our basic school uniform items of plain black full length trousers, plain black skirt, plain white shirt/blouse, black or navy blue shalwar kamiz/jalbaab can be purchased relatively cheaply from any high street or supermarket clothes retailer. Attendance

Attendance at school is compulsory. There is strong evidence that tells us students who attend school regularly achieve better and are happier at school. Your support in ensuring students attend school is vital. More details regarding attendance will follow over the summer break.

Equipment

In order to prepare for the new term, and be ready for learning the following is a list of expected equipment:

It is very important that you have the following equipment with you while at school.



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Mobile phones

- Mobile phones are allowed in school for the acknowledged safety and contact reasons (before and after the school day only - contact during the school day for any urgent communication should be through the school office on 01234 342521
- Mobile phones and headphones MUST be kept in a bag during the school day and not visible (this includes charging phones during lessons, phones out on the desks, or phones visible in pockets where they can distract students during lessons).
- Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent before the lesson starts and before entering the classroom (not on vibrate which can distract students during lessons)
- Students will not be allowed to listen to music during lesson time
- Mobile phones can be used (if required) during lunchtimes and break times. However, we strongly recommend that students engage in the school life around them and not their devices. We have plenty of extra-curricular activities on offer.

Travel to school

We promote healthy lifestyles and encourage students to walk or cycle to school. Please remind students to cycle carefully, wear reflective clothing and a cycle helmet. For safety tips follow this <u>link</u>. If you bring a child to school by car please drive carefully and use the drop off/pick up points marked on the drive.

Cashless system (ParentPay)

All of our food outlets will be open fully in the new term and we will be continuing with our cashless system for food and all other school purchases including trips and visits. You will have already received information about our new cashless system for payments. If you have not already set up an account or will be new to the school in September you will receive your unique ParentPay Account activation letters shortly. Family support over summer

- <u>Free school meals vouchers</u>. Bedford Borough Council are providing vouchers over the summer for all families eligible for income related free school meals. Voucher codes are sent directly by email to eligible families.


Biddenham International School & Sports College HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT Ready - Respect - Reward
